CONGRATULATORY MESSAGES

A Very Special Anniversary or Birthday Gift

Australians who are celebrating a milestone birthday or wedding anniversary can receive personal congratulations from the Prime Minister, Governor-General or The King.

Who is eligible for a congratulatory message?

- The Prime Minister will send a message of congratulations to people turning 90 years of age (or more).
- The King and Governor-General will send a message on a 100th birthday.
- On request, the Prime Minister and the Governor-General will write again every year and The King will write again every five years following the 100th Birthday.
- The Prime Minister and Governor-General send messages to couples celebrating 50 years of marriage and subsequent wedding anniversaries.
- The King will send messages to couples celebrating 60 years of marriage and will write every five years after that on request.

Where will the special message be delivered?

Congratulatory messages can go to the recipient's address or to a care-of address if it is to be a surprise.

When do I arrange the message?

All requests need to be made a minimum of 5 weeks before the date of the anniversary or birthday. If this year's celebration has passed, you can still request a belated message up to a month afterwards.
